

Case studies – more detailed description of selected runs

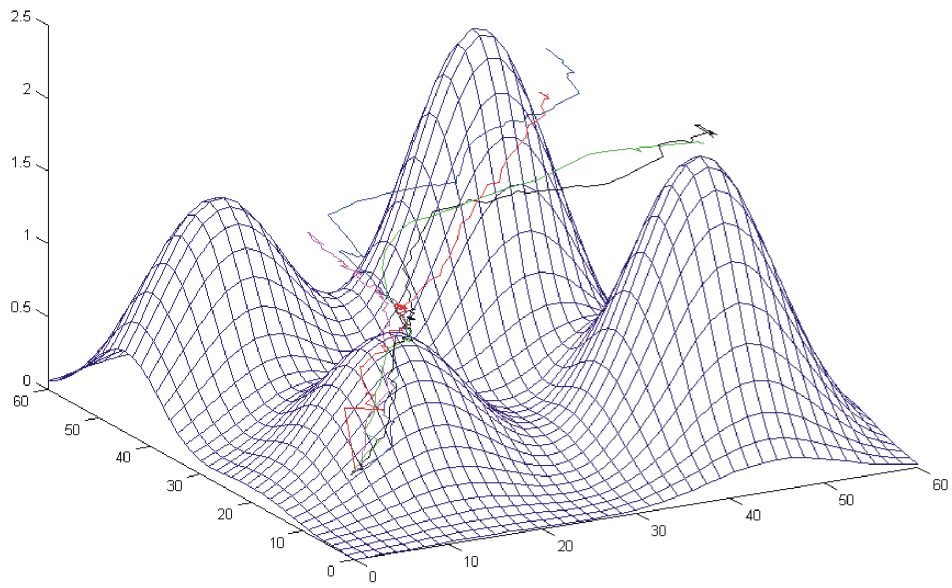


Figure 24b. Selected trajectories of development in four peaks landscape

Five specific simulations in the four peaks adaptive landscape have been selected, namely:

sz4j2 – blue trajectory in Fig. 24, below; relative quick sequence of radical innovations: in year 45 on the second peak, in 50 on the third peak and in 100 in the fourth peak.

sz4j5 – red trajectory; three times radical innovations ‘paced’ on the second peak have been lost; in 115 two radical innovation placed on the third and on the fourth peak caused segmentation of the market into two groups of products of similar competitiveness.

sz4p11 – green trajectory; lock-in of industry growth in the third peak; radical technical innovation placed on the fourth peak has been not accepted because of poor economic evaluations.

sz4p6 – magenta trajectory; very similar case to sz4j5 but segmentation between two lower peaks.

sz4p16 – black trajectory; very similar case to sz4j11, lock-in in the third peak.

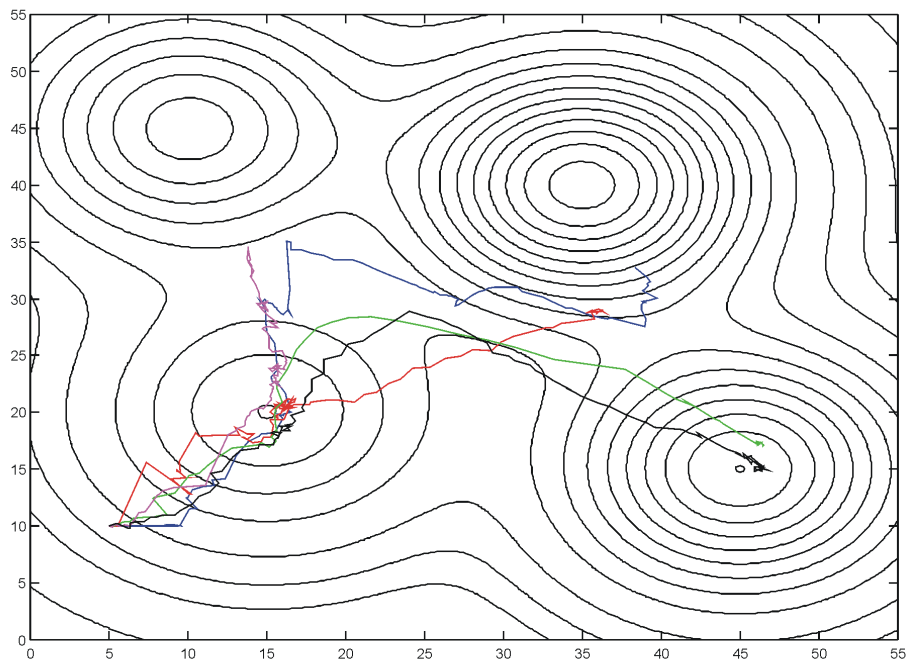


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
